In the past, she has been working as a postdoctoral fellow of the European Community with Prof. Brånemark (Institute for Applied Biotechnology) and Prof. B. Rydevik (Department Orthopedics, University of Göteborg) in Göteborg, Sweden (1994–1995). Reinhilde has received the IADR Young Investigators Award (1998) and the Belgian Joachim Award in the Odontostomatology (1999). She has extensive editorial experience from working with a number of different journals.

As our new Associate Editor, Reinhilde Jacobs will continue Daniel's work and further emphasize the important and growing field of imaging in clinical oral research. Reinhilde, welcome on Board!
