This textbook is aimed at undergraduate and postgraduate dental students who are preparing for qualifications prior to specialization. It would also be useful for the general dental practitioner.

The text covers both academic and clinical aspects of the three disciplines of restorative dentistry, paediatric dentistry, and orthodontics, in sufficient detail to provide an excellent foundation for readers. The sections are well structured and readable with illustrations that are clear and compliment the text. The use of tables and highlighted points make the information accessible and precise.

The inclusion of learning objectives and self-assessments in each section make this is a valuable learning and revision aid. For those approaching examinations, the variety of questions is stimulating and good practice.

This book is ideal for students, who can use it as an introduction before exploring more specialized books and read it as part of their revision.
