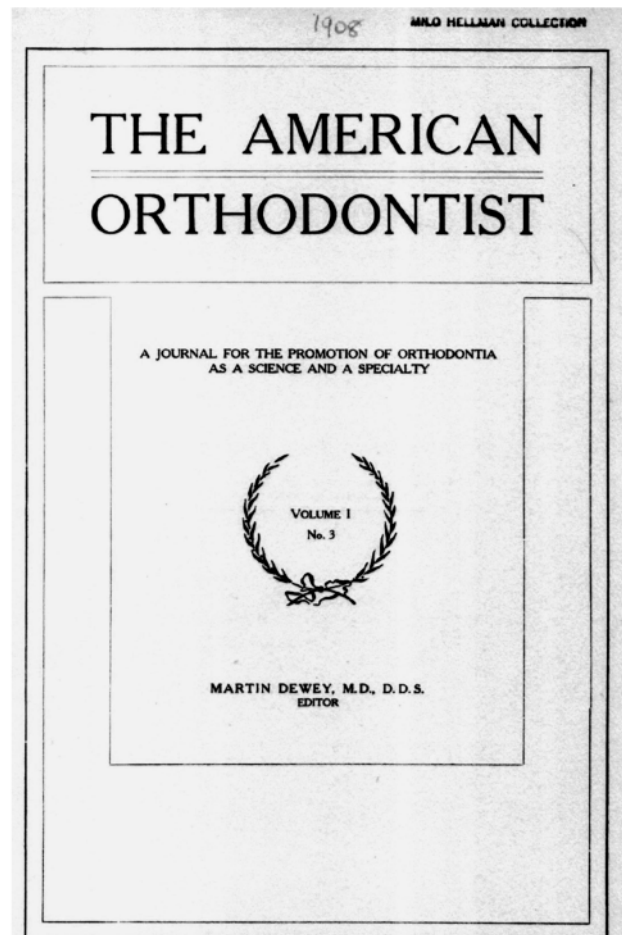


1st EOS Congress, Berlin, 1907
