

## Max Horsnell Travel Bursary

The British Society of Paediatric Dentistry (BSPD) has established the Max Horsnell Travel Bursary to support BSPD members who wish to present a poster or oral communication at scientific meetings of the European Academy of Paediatric Dentistry or the International Association of Paediatric Dentistry.

The details of the award are listed below:

- Two awards of £500 will be available per annum. If not awarded, the amount will be carried over to the following year.
- Written applications must include: the applicant's name and contact details; the name of the employing institution; current position held; an abstract of the paper to be submitted; and details of the conference at which paper is to be presented. The abstract should be limited

to 250 words and be structured to include: objectives; design; setting; sample and methods; results; and conclusions. Case reports should be structured to include: presenting problem; clinical management; and discussion.

- The BSPD president and a senior scientific advisor, who is not connected to the applicant's employing institution, will consider the applications.

- Applicants will receive a reply within 2 weeks of the Bursary closing date.
