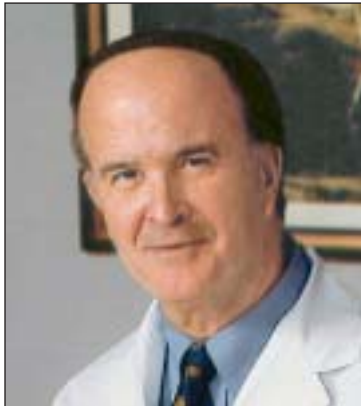


George Zarb to be Awarded Membership in the Order of Canada



Her Excellency the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean, Governor General of Canada, will award George Zarb membership in the Order of Canada later this year for his “contributions and leadership in prosthodontic dentistry, notably for introducing dental implantology to North American dentists.” This is a very prestigious award made by the Governor General on the recommendations of the Advisory Council on the Order of Canada, an independent council chaired by the Chief Justice of Canada. The Order of Canada is the centerpiece of Canada’s honours system established to recognize citizens who have made extraordinary achievements in various fields of endeavor.

The prosthodontic community globally is very well aware of George Zarb’s excellent and sustained scholarship, teaching, and service both as a professor at the University of Toronto and as editor of this international journal; however, this new award is fitting acknowledgment in Canada of the widespread contribution he has made to dentistry and healthcare generally. —*Michael MacEntee*
