

2012 Frechette Awards Announced

The winners of the 2012 Frechette Awards were recently presented at the International Association for Dental Research (IADR) annual meeting in Iguazu Falls, Brazil. The Frechette is the annual research competition for new investigators sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group of the IADR and honoring the memory of Arthur R. Frechette who served as Secretary-Treasurer of the IADR from 1968 until 1977. The winners were **Dr. Shinya Uraguchi**, Osaka University, Osaka, Japan for “Enhanced Osteogenesis of iPS Cells by Id2 Gene Knock-out” and **Dr. D. Mota Moreira**, University of Texas-San Antonio/Health Science Ctr, San Antonio, Texas for “Antibacterial Activity of a Novel Silver Nanoparticle-Loaded Orthodontic Band Cement.”

each received a check for \$1000, thanks to the generous support of the Whip Mix Corporation.

New investigators in Prosthodontics are encouraged to apply for one of two 2013 Arthur R. Frechette Research Awards in Prosthodontics. Each Award recognizes original research by new investigators and is sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group of the IADR and supported by the Whip Mix Corporation. One award is for Prosthodontic research undertaken with a Materials Science or Bioengineering oriented protocol and the other is for Prosthodontic research undertaken with a Biological Sciences and Tissue Engineering oriented protocol. Researchers carrying out original research are eligible for the Frechette Award if they have been the primary author of no more than three articles

In addition to the plaques Drs. Uraguchi and Moreira

published in refereed dental journals. Each award carries a cash prize of \$1000.

Research submitted for the IADR meeting in Seattle, WA is eligible for consideration for the Frechette Award, provided it has not been published elsewhere or will not be under consideration for another award. Abstracts must be submitted to the Prosthodontics Group of the IADR by the IADR deadline (October 5, 2012) with the appropriate boxes on the on-line submission checked. The abstracts will be judged for (1) originality and scientific design of the investigation, (2) suitability of the methods of analysis, and (3) scientific value of the work. Selected finalists will be judged at the 2013 IADR meeting in Seattle, WA (March 20 to 23, 2013), and the winner will be announced at the Prosthodontics Group Business Meeting.
