Board-certified or board-eligible public health dentists are invited to inquire about this advanced level position with the Palm Beach County Health Department. The Dental Executive Director supervises approximately 40 personnel in a five-clinic, 30-chair clinical program that targets Medicaid children as well as adult members of the County Health Care Taxing District entitlement program. Our Public Health Dentistry Division administers a community-based fluoridation initiative, and school-based fluoride mouthrinse (40,000 children) and sealant (2,000 children) programs. We have a highly qualified and loyal staff with long tenure and low turnover. The successful candidate will participate in public health medical and dental residency training programs. Excellent relationships with the private dental sector and school board offer opportunities for innovative linkages. Florida dental license is preferred, but not mandatory. The Dental Executive Director is expected to be active in local dental association activities and to participate in community coalitions relative to oral health initiatives. Our \$2.7 million budget is generated through the clinical program as well as grants and contracts. Position will become available May 1, 2003, and will provide a two-month overlap with the incumbent director.

The Department of Community Dentistry invites applications for a one-year full-time or a two-year part-time residency in dental public health. This accredited program allows dentists with the MPH or its equivalent to complete the educational requirements for board certification as a specialist in dental public health. The residency prepares for careers in academic, federal, state, and local health departments, community health centers, industry, and the military. The department has programs in epidemiology, oral disease prevention and health promotion, nutrition, cariology, sialochemistry, health services research and development, and co-operates in several school and community health center clinical programs. Other resources to the program include the Texas Department of Health, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District, and the University of Texas School of Public Health, San Antonio Program.
